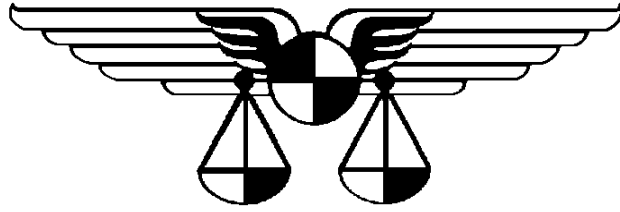

#### *Background*

Papers and reports are published and distributed.

#### *Abstracts*

Paper abstracts should include the title and the author's name, school and position. They should be 250-350 words in length and should contain a statement of the problem or objective, the method of approach, and a summary of conclusions. The abstract should not deal with specific data. Send one copy to the Vice President – Technical Director by 15 Dec. 2007. Abstracts will be reviewed for technical track assignment. Final papers are due by 17 April 2009.

Student awards of **\$1000** and **\$500** will be awarded for the two best student papers.
