## HOLLOW DREAMS

Take the high road to Scotland then take the fast track all the way back

Doubling up as the world's most expensive cheese-grater, the Arantix's unique frame design weaves aerospace-grade carbon fibre with super-strong Kevlar to pull the frame's weight down to a ridiculous sub-1.2kg while maintaining strength and rigidity. "The most responsive frame we've ever tested, flying up hills, but giving complete control at every turn," says Ian Collins, from mountain biking magazine *MBUK*.

**WHAT?** The Highland Wildcat Trails, Golspie, Scotland

**WHY?** You can tackle both the longest descent in the UK from the 1300m summit of Ben Bhraggie all the way down to sea level, and the UK's longest, purpose-built single-track ascent, in one fell swoop. Views across the Highlands and over the Moray Firth undoubtedly beat the hell out of your morning commute, too.
