

REMINDER

The SAWE Awards Committee will be accepting nominations for the following awards until March 1, 2019:

- Ed Payne Award – for an outstanding young engineer (under the age of 35 at the time of submittal) who has made significant contributions to the SAWE or the Mass Properties Engineering profession
- Fellow – for an engineer who has made material contributions to the SAWE or has achieved distinction in the field of Mass Properties Engineering
- Honorary Fellow – for an engineer who has made outstanding contributions to the SAWE or has achieved eminence in the field of Mass Properties Engineering
- Richard Boynton Lifetime Achievement Award – this candidate must have shown extraordinary support of the SAWE over a large number of years

The Awards Committee will evaluate candidate submittals according to the above criteria and the information contained on candidate sponsor forms that can be found on the SAWE website at <https://www.sawe.org/news/awardnominations2019>. The Committee can select up to 2 candidates for the Ed Payne Award, up to 5 for Fellow, and up to 2 for Honorary Fellow, but just 1 per year for the Richard Boynton Award. The nomination profiles of those candidates selected by the Committee will be presented to the Board of Directors at the International Conference BoD meeting on the Saturday prior to the start of the Conference. A three-quarters vote of assent is required for approval. The awards will then be presented at the Banquet the following Wednesday.

I encourage every SAWE member to recognize those colleagues who have made a difference in the promotion of Mass Properties Engineering by submitting their names and achievements in the appropriate award category.
