SAWE Code of Ethics

The Society of Allied Weight Engineers (SAWE) is an international organization whose purpose is to promote the mass properties discipline and provide members and industry a medium for exchanging practices and experiences with the objective of fostering a higher degree of quality in mass properties control. In pursuing the objective of SAWE, members shall uphold and advance the integrity, honor, and dignity of the engineering profession by:

- 1. Using their knowledge and skill for the benefit of mankind.
- 2. Striving to increase the competence and prestige of the mass properties engineering profession.
- 3. Carrying on their professional work in a spirit of fairness and fidelity to employer, contractors, and the public, with loyalty to their country, and devotion to the high ideals of courtesy and personal honor.

The Fundamental Canons

- A. The Society's Professionals shall hold paramount the safety, health, and welfare of the public in the performance of their professional duties.
- B. The Society's Professionals shall continue their professional development throughout their careers and provide competent services only in their areas of expertise.
- C. The Society's Professionals shall build their professional reputation on the merit of their services and shall not compete unfairly with others.
- D. The Society's Professionals shall respect the proprietary information and intellectual property rights of others, including professional societies in the engineering field.
- E. The Society's Professionals shall avoid conflicts of interest or the appearance of conflicts of interest and be vigilant to avoid behavior which may raise suspicions of illegal collusion.
- F. The Society's Professionals shall advertise in a dignified and truthful manner avoiding any conduct which brings discredit upon the profession.
- G. The Society's Professionals shall treat all persons with respect, fairness, dignity, and never engage in any form of harassment or discrimination.
- H. The Society's Professionals shall mentor or seek mentors to learn, build their network, and grow professionally.
